- 3. Please record activities or number of minutes on your online reading log before coming to the library to collect rewards.
- 4. Rewards can be claimed at the library beginning JUNE 3.
- 5. One reward per young person per summer.
- 6. Last day to pick up rewards is August 31, 2024.
